Purchase contract

Gender Requested/Preferred (circle): Male / Female / First Available Price of Pups in Litter: \$650.00

This contract is a commitment to adopt a puppy from Kentucky Puggles (breeder) and an agreement between both client and breeder. A \$100 deposit will reserve a puppy for adoption for this client and is placed on reserve litter list. The deposit will be applied to the adoption price of a puppy and held for a term of ONE year. If breeder fails to provide client with a puppy of their preferred gender within one year, or the pup chosen becomes sick, injured or dies before leaving breeders' facility, said deposit will become fully refundable. If at any time client **cancel**s their contract and elects not to adopt a puppy for any other reason, the deposit is forfeited. **Should a puppy be available** to client and client elects to **postpone** adoption (at birth of litter), deposit is no longer refundable but client can be moved to the end of the reserve list ONE TIME to accept a pup on later litter, move to the extended reserved waiting list for a period no longer than 2 years or cancel their contract and forfeit deposit. Should client refuse adoption of available puppy twice while on the reserve list, their contract will be cancelled and deposit forfeited. Should another puppy of the opposite gender be available (not adopted), client and breeder may elect that a substitution be made. If at any time client moves to the extended wait list without available puppy, their contract is held for 2 years and deposit is no longer refundable. Clients moving from extended to reserve list are placed at the bottom of the list.

Once litter is born, client will be asked to confirm commitment for adopting available puppy. Confirmation must take place within 72 hours or puppy may be offered to another client. Once confirmed, a puppy shall be considered adopted and not available to any other party. Client agrees to make scheduled installments on remaining balance (minus deposit) as follows: 1/3 balance at 2 weeks of age, 1/3 balance at 4 weeks of age and remaining balance along with any PayPal and/or shipping fees at 6 weeks. If any installments are made via PayPal, there is a one time \$25 PayPal fee added to adoption price to cover expenses incurred by Kentucky Puggles for clients' use of PayPal. Should client pay entire balance of pup in full by 2 weeks of age, said one time fee will be waived. If puppy is shipped to client, an additional cost of \$300 will apply (subject to increase). Cost of shipping expenses will be confirmed by breeder upon birth of litter. Shipping expenses are the sole responsibility of the client. All expenses must be paid in certified funds prior to release of puppy. Should client elect to **cancel** their adoption contract after any installments have been paid, all monies are forfeited and puppy remains in breeders' ownership to be re-adopted. Should client elect to **postpone** adoption, all monies will be held with breeder and client will be placed at the bottom of the reserved litter list and wait for another puppy not to extend any longer than one year. If client elects not to adopt pup a second time, Kentucky Puggles will cancel contract and all monies paid will be forfeited. Once client has confirmed adoption of puppy, at no time are funds refundable unless client continues with adoption and a chosen puppy becomes sick, injured or dies.

At their discretion, breeder will release pups for pick up at 6 weeks of age or keep pups until 8 weeks of age. Puppies being shipped must remain until 8 weeks of age. Breeder will provide all needed care for puppy while at their home. No pup will be released prior to 6 weeks of age. For the safety and wellbeing of your pup, breeder has the right to delay shipment of pup during extreme temperatures. Puppies held with breeder **after** 8 weeks of age will incur a \$10 per day boarding fee and any needed veterinary care expenses. All expenses must be paid in certified funds prior to release of puppy. Breeder reserves the right to cancel this contract in the event of nonpayment per schedule or lack of communication from client within 1 year; therefore it is vital that client communicate change in phone, email and address to breeder.

All pups will be examined by a veterinarian prior to being released from breeder. Should breeder be aware of any medical issue prior to leaving their home, breeder will inform client and price compensation may be offered. Should client accept pup upon disclosure of such, breeder is relieved of all further liability. Client acknowledges that adopting a living being carries an inherent risk for illness or injury at some point in their lifetime. Care and handling of the pup can greatly affect their overall health, bone structure, conformation, disposition and personality and breeder does not guarantee such. Since breeder has no control of conditions once pup leaves their facility, breeder extends a 72-hour health guarantee against any illness or death due to communicable diseases **ONLY**. Client must take puppy to veterinarian within 72 hours of receiving puppy or guarantee becomes null and void. Breeder is not liable for any accident or injury to the pup after being picked up at their home or released to the airline carrier. Should illness or death due to communicable disease occur within 72 hours, client must contact the breeder immediately. Client will provide veterinary statement to breeder stating the cause of illness or death to be examined by the breeder's veterinarian. Should claim be justifiable by both veterinarians, breeder will provide a replacement puppy if available or refund purchase price of puppy once puppy is returned to breeder or death confirmed by veterinarian. Shipping expenses are NOT refundable. Breeder is not responsible for any veterinary expenses after puppy leaves their home. For the protective health and safety of your pup, it is advised that your pup not be permitted in areas where other dogs roam until he or she has received their full vaccination protocol. It is client's responsibility to obtain permissions and pay deposits if in a tenant situation. It is also the client's responsibility to fully research and understand the commitment involved in pet ownership and be prepared for such. Any puppy purchased from breeder will require further training, which is the sole responsibility of client. A copy of the pups' medical record will be provided to client. It is strongly recommended that you contact your veterinarian to establish a vaccination, worming and check up schedule.

Contract is drawn in the state of Kentucky. Any claims against this contract are to be filed in Warren County, Kentucky.

Client gives implied acceptance of terms of this contract upon placement of deposit whether via electronic or personal payment.
